About the Program

Moraine Park's Chiropractic Technician Certificate prepares students for work as chiropractic assistants, and allows students to earn both the chiropractic technician and chiropractic radiological technician state certifications.

The certificate program consists of two courses that are part of the Health and Wellness (<https://catalog.morainepark.edu/programs/health-wellness-aas/>) associate degree program and can be used toward completion of that degree.

Upon completion, students will satisfy the state of Wisconsin current requirements for Chiropractic Technician and Chiropractic Radiographic Technician certification¹ in the areas of therapies, exercise, preliminary examination, case history and radiography.

What You'll Learn

Students gain hands-on experience in many of the daily tasks of chiropractic technicians, including taking x-rays and assisting in patient therapy and exercise, keeping track of patient records and answering chiropractic-related questions.
